Dear Ms. Caneco:

On September 1, 2005, National Contractors Insurance Company, Inc. a Risk Retention Group submitted an application to become registered in California as a risk retention group. Said application was supplemented and amended on February 1, 2006, July 30, and September 21, 2007. Wherefore, it appears National Contractors Insurance Company, Inc. a Risk Retention Group has provided all required information pursuant to the Federal Liability Risk Retention Act of 1986 and the California Risk Retention Act of 1991.

The risk retention group should be aware that, effective January 1, 1996, California Insurance Code section 132(j) (1), (2) & (3) requires annual re-registration of a risk retention group in order to keep its registration in force. To maintain its registration in force, each risk retention group must file its re-registration materials and pay a \$300 re-registration fee on or before December 31 of every subsequent year.

Pursuant to California Insurance Code section 132(k), it is the ongoing responsibility of the risk retention group to promptly report to this Department any change of address, contact person, plan of operation or any other change of information which was provided in its initial Statement of Registration.
